

MEADOWS COUNTRY MARKET – TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Second Sunday of the every month

Managed by the Meadows Memorial Hall Inc Market Committee

1. The Meadows Memorial Hall and surrounds is owned by the District Council of Mount Barker. The Council has insurance covering the hall and the Meadows Memorial Hall Committee, but does not cover stallholders, their helpers or their products. The Council therefore requires each stallholder to have their own insurance, and product liability insurance if you sell food products.
2. The market is open to the public from **9am to 3pm** as advertised each month. You are expected to continue trading until 3pm unless sold out or are given permission to leave by one of the organisers. Please do not pack up if customers still want to buy.
3. No Stallholders are to move vehicles throughout the market area during the opening hours. This is an insurance risk.
4. Please book your site from month to month. If you have booked and cannot attend please contact one of the people at the bottom of the page.
This allows us to reallocate your site to someone else. The inside sites are setup on Thursday so it is expected that you will notify us prior to this if you are unable to attend.
5. If you are able to help advertise the market by distributing flyers or you know of a place where we could advertise please let the organisers know. Your help is beneficial to the entire market.
6. No raffle tickets are to be sold at the market
7. Outside stall sites are generally 3m x 3m. Outside stallholders please make sure all tables, signs and marquees are safe for you, the public and other stallholders. All these items **MUST BE TIED DOWN SECURELY** in case of unexpected wind gusts or poor weather.
8. Please put your goods on tables or behind your stall so that no one can trip over them. This is a safety requirement.
9. Standard inside sites are 1.8m or 6 feet long. All table covers need to go to the floor in front of your trestle to cover excess stock or boxes, ie no boxes in front of the trestle.
10. Please unload your car and move it to the car park **before 8:15am** as stallholders outside need to setup as well. Also we need to have all cars out of the trade space before the public come through at 9am. If you are running late please call Ruth or Tyson otherwise your site will be reallocated.
11. Parking for inside stallholders will be along the eastern side fence line behind the hall. Parking for outside stallholders is to be in the paddock made available for customer parking also. No vehicles are to be on site unless prior arrangements have been made with the organisers. If any doubts of where to park please speak to one of the committee members.
12. The cost of a stall is \$10 for an outside stall (3mx3m) and inside is \$12.00 for a six foot trestle space. It is \$3.00 to hire a trestle table from the hall.

Thankyou for your cooperation and support of the market. Our committee members will do their best to help you as stallholders. If you have any ideas to improve the market please feel free to speak to one of the organisers. All proceeds of the market go towards improvements to the hall and the market, advertising signs, maintenance of the hall etc
